- 1. <u>Education projects of single Clubs, MD 111</u> Hermann Heinemann presents three projects in Ethiopia, Kenya and Namibia
- Maternal and Child Mortality in Africa, MD 411 Jayna Shah, MD 411 Kenya, presents Lions of Kenya fighting against Maternal and Child Mortality. It is still one of the highest in the world. More than 6,000 Kenyan women die every year due to pregnancy related causes. Lack of education, women have no chance to decide when to get pregnant, limited access to care, inadequate health facilities. Strengthen maternal clinics, sex education, many challenges.
- <u>"Bonsomnooré: move from words to deeds" in Burkina Faso, MD 108</u> Franco Marchesani: Presents a micro loan service in Burkina Faso. Mechanic grain mills, income by selling pancakes, mills to feed 10,000 people.

The chairperson presents the resolution taken in the closed meeting before:

"Preamble:

The Euro Africa Committee discusses in detail the present problems of youth and women in Africa, especially the many migrant Africans to Europe recently due to poverty and many social problems faced in Africa. To assist these needs youth and women we are proposing the following resolution.

Resolution:

The Euro Africa Committee recommends that for impact accountability and sustainability of projects and activities in Africa, that Lions Clubs and districts in Europe partner with respective Lions Clubs and districts in Africa and focus on youth and women projects which is a big need in Africa at moment".

Xavier de Franssu explains the focus of the discussion and the participant unanimously approve the resolution.

Cesara Pasini presents the "Africa Lions Day in EXPO 2015" in Milan. - 7. <u>Solar cookers, MD 107 Finland.</u> Heikki Saarinen presents the project "solar cookers" in Kenya from NSR and LC Helsinki, simply to produce with plywood and aluminum foil to keep warm with rockwool, low costs. To avoid waste of trees. Total budget 250,000 € mostly from NSR.
